To make your tile selection experience as smooth and productive as possible, consider bringing the following items when you visit:

Photos of the Area

Capture images of the space to be tiled, including wide shots and close-ups of surrounding features like walls, floors, or architectural details.

Inspiration Pictures

Bring images of designs or styles you love, whether from magazines, social media, or websites. These help us understand your vision and aesthetic preferences.

Paint Swatches

Include any paint chips or samples of the colors already in your space or planned for your project.

Wallpaper Samples

If your space features wallpaper or will in the future, bring a sample to ensure harmony in your design.

Countertop Samples

Provide a sample or detailed photo of your countertops to coordinate textures, colors, and finishes.

Cabinet Samples

Bring cabinet doors, drawer fronts, or finish samples to create a cohesive look.

Flooring Samples

If your project includes or affects existing flooring, bring a piece or detailed image of it.
